



THE TERRACES AT SKYLINE

Private Pay, Non-Medicaid Participation Notice

Effective Date: January 1, 2009

The Terraces at Skyline is a licensed Boarding Home and, as of the date of this notice, does not participate in the Medicaid program in the State of Washington.

Therefore, if you are no longer able to pay the monthly fee for services, The Terraces at Skyline may discharge you for nonpayment should you not pay the first invoice, or statement of charges due, from The Terraces at Skyline. The discharge would happen even if you are eligible for Medicaid covered services. The Terraces at Skyline will provide at least 30 days notice prior to the effective date of transfer or discharge for reasons of nonpayment.

If The Terraces at Skyline begins participating in the Medicaid program in the future, and if The Terraces at Skyline has an available Medicaid bed at the time you become eligible for Medicaid, then you may continue to reside in The Terraces at Skyline and receive services.
